Home Learning - You will have weekly spellings to learn, books to read and a weekly talking homework task. Later on in the year there will be a written homework activity.


Dear Parents

We want to make the transition as easy as possible for your child. During next term you can help your child by:

- ◆ Ensuring that **ALL** their possessions and clothing are named and easily identifiable (You wouldn't believe how tricky it is trying to match unnamed clothing with the correct child!)
- ◆ Encouraging your child's growing independence – letting them sort out their own reading folder, coat, shoes etc.
- ◆ Listening to them read, or ask them about their books and encourage them to read **as often as possible**.
- ◆ Practising mathematical skills in a friendly and informal way – number games and songs.
- ◆ Encouraging and supporting them to do their weekly home learning.
